## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

Bongo drums are one of the oldest musical instruments and play an important role in Latin American music. In the past hundreds of years, the shape of the bongo drum has not changed. It is still made of two hollow wooden drums, like a wooden barrel, connected together by a bridge in the middle, and then used animal leather filmed on the surface, usually goat leather or buffalo leather, then fixed with a metal ring, and adjust the tone of the drum by stretching the drum surface.

Bongo drums are combination by two wooden drum, MACHO and HEMBRA



How to perform:

Open: hit the drum with your finger

Bass: Beat the drum head with your palm

Crash: Hit the drumhead with your palm, and then use your fingers to gently press the drum goat skin

Mute: Lightly press the drum with your left thumb and hit the drum with your right hand

Rim Shot: hit the edge of drum with your fingers

How to tuning:

Tuning: Bongo drums do not have a fixed pitch. Everyone adjusts according to their own preferences. You can also find your favorite tuning method. If the drum's surface is loose or the sound does not sound good, you can put the drum face down on your legs, use a tuning wrench to turn the tuning screw clockwise, and then press all the tuning screws of the two drums in sequence. Twist the above method again, and then flip the drum head over and knock for a while. If you are still dissatisfied with the timbre, turn each screw half a turn as described above, and then try the timbre, and so on until you get a satisfactory timbre. Note that the pitch of the left drum is greater than that of the right drum.

Maintenance: If you don't use it for a long time, you need to loosen the drum goat skin a little.
